Dear Frank:

The third paragraph in your letter of December 22nd, bothers me as you must still have in your mind that I am looking for a municipally owned stadium. You must know that is not the case, Frank. The only government assistance I want is in its power to assemble a site which we will buy and on which we will build and maintain a stadium. We, of course, want it at a location where there can be all year round parking income as otherwise the cost of a new stadium would not be justified on the income from baseball alone.

Can you have any serious doubt in your mind on this point. I really feel that I have been quite clear that we do not expect the government to finance and own our proposed new stadium.
