\$6,000,000 Cost Shelves Dodger Stadium Designs

Norman Bel Geddes, theatrical designer, has drawn plans for a stadium of concrete and stainless steel that will seat 80,000 spectators, Walter F. O'Malley, Brooklyn Dodgers' vice-president, said yesterday.

O'Malley added they were drawn to fit the present acreage of Ebbets Field "but that the

cost is \$6,000,000."

He pointed out that the entire New York Yankee holdings, including all players and the Stadiums at New York and Kansas City, were sold two and a half years ago for \$3,000,000.

"We appreciate that the Brooklyn fans are entitled to more seats in a modern stadium, but it just does not seem possible in the near future," O'Malley said.

The present stands at Ebbets Field can hold 35,000.
